Notification

No. S.O. 70/H.A. 6/2003/S. 57/2014.—Whereas, the Government of Haryana, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 57 of the Haryana Value Added Tax Act, 2003 (Act 6 of 2003), and in supersession of Haryana Government, Excise and Taxation Department, Notification No. 983-ET-4-2013/714, dated the 1st April, 2013, constitutes a Tribunal to be called the Haryana Tax Tribunal consisting of three or more odd number of members including the Chairman, as the State Government may appoint for the purpose of performing such functions and exercising such powers as may be assigned to, or conferred on, the Tribunal by or under the said Act;

And, whereas, the qualifications of the Chairman and the Members have been prescribed in section 57 of the Haryana Value Added Tax Act, 2003;

Now, therefore, the Governor of Haryana hereby notifies the procedure as given below, for appointment of the Chairman and the Members of the Haryana Tax Tribunal, namely :—

1. There shall be a Search Committee consisting of three members under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana. The other members shall include one retired judge of a Hon'ble High Court and the Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department. The Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department shall be the ex-officio convener of the Committee.
2. Whenever a vacancy is to be filled in the Haryana Tax Tribunal, a press note shall be issued and the same shall be uploaded, in the notice section, on www.haryanatax.com.
3. The Search Committee shall consider all the names which come to its notice or are forwarded to it by any person or aspirant. The Search Committee shall prepare a panel of suitable candidates in view of the qualifications contained in section 57 of the Haryana Value Added Tax Act, 2003, equal to three times the number of vacancy/vacancies.

4. The report of the Search Committee shall be prepared strictly in can alphabetical order (considering the first name of the candidate) and shall be placed before the State Government, with all relevant material and relative merits of the candidates, for approval of the name of the appointee(s).
5. The Office of the Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department or any other office/officer appointed by the Principal Secretary to Government, Haryana, Excise and Taxation Department shall provide secretarial assistance to the Search Committee.
