

**Expression of Interest**

**“Creation of Haryana GST Kosh- Online Knowledge  
Repository of GST Acts and Rules”**

**Excise and Taxation Department  
Government of Haryana**

1. The Department of Excise & Taxation, Government of Haryana is planning to launch an E-Library by the name of Haryana GST Kosh, which will be an online knowledge repository of all State and Central GST Acts, Rules, Circulars, Notifications, Court Rulings etc.
2. The E-Library will be created as a separate link in the Haryana Excise and Taxation Department Website. Government of Haryana seeks Expression of Interest from interested parties to be empanelled as Knowledge Partners for Haryana GST Kosh project.

### **Scope of Work**

3. The scope of work shall include but not limit to providing updated content in a pre-defined format to the system integrator / website development team of the Excise and Taxation Department, Government of Haryana.
4. The knowledge partner shall be able to provide the following on regular intervals :
  - a. Bare CGST, HGST, UTGST, IGST, and Compensation Cess Acts and Rules
  - b. Updated amendments to CGST, HGST, UTGST, IGST, and Compensation Cess Acts and Rules
  - c. Compilation of Rate related notifications
  - d. All other Notifications, Circulars, Orders, Removal of Difficulty Order, GST Council Decisions etc.
  - e. Important GST related judgment of High Courts, Supreme Courts etc.
  - f. Any other GST related content as requested.

### **Terms and Conditions**

5. **No remuneration / financial consideration shall be provided for the services rendered by the Knowledge Partner. However, the webpage of Haryana GST Kosh will display the names of the Knowledge Partners.**
6. Initially, only three knowledge partners will be empanelled. This number may be increased as per the interests received and the volume of work.
7. Empanelment shall remain valid for a period of 1 year from the date of empanelment. The work of the Knowledge Partner will be reviewed after one year and the same may be re-empanelled if the work is satisfactory. However, in case the work of the Knowledge Partners is found unsatisfactory, the Government of Haryana will reserve the right to remove such Knowledge Partners with immediate effect.
8. Interested Knowledge Partners are advised to study the Expression of Interest document carefully. Submission of Expression of Interest shall be deemed to have been done after careful study and examination of the Expression of Interest document with full understanding of its implications.
9. The Department will consider the Expression of Interest of firms and Companies only and individual Advocates/CAs will not be considered for empanelment as Knowledge Partners.
10. The Department of Excise & Taxation, Haryana may stop the process of this empanelment without citing any reason.

### **Qualification to Apply**

11. Any organization, company, association etc. specializing in GST Acts and rules may apply to be empanelled as Knowledge Partner. Such organization, company, association etc. should have at least three years of

experience with either GST laws or other indirect laws in force before the introduction of GST.

### **Empanelment Procedure**

12. Interested parties may email their proposals to [deepa.chaudhary@haryanatax.gov.in](mailto:deepa.chaudhary@haryanatax.gov.in) and send hard copies to AETC (GST), Room No.307, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Vanijya Bhawan, Plot 1-3, Sector 5, Panchkula, Haryana 134108.
13. Proposals should include financial statements such as balance sheet and income tax returns for the last three financial years. It should also include credentials and work done in GST related domain. It should specifically provide the details of the team that will work on the project including their credentials. One designated point of contact for project coordination should also be provided.
14. The interested party should provide an undertaking that no legal proceedings, prosecutions etc. are pending against the interested party in any Court of Law. If any such proceedings or investigations are found pending in any Court or legal forum, such empanelment shall be immediately cancelled.
15. The last date of sending the proposal is 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021. Selected parties may be called for a presentation on their proposals.
